Ellsworth Springs Condominium Association Pool and Spa Rules

- 1. There is no lifeguard on duty. Use of the pool and spa are at the user's own risk.
- 2. The pool and spa are open from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM daily. Please respect residents living near the pool and spa while using the facility at all times, especially during evening hours.
- 3. Unit owners who are delinquent in paying their monthly assessment (condominium dues) are prohibited from using the spa and pool area in its entirety.
- 4. Residents have first priority. The pool and spa are for the exclusive use of residents and their invited guests. Residents are granted the privilege of inviting guests to use the pool and spa, provided there are no more than four guests per household at any one time. Guests must be accompanied at all times by a resident aged 18 or older.
- 5. Minors aged 17 and under must be accompanied at all times by an adult resident aged 18 or older. The supervision of children shall be strictly observed. Children shall be continuously monitored while in, around or in proximity of the pool. Children under the age of six are not allowed in the spa. No disposable diapers are allowed in the pool or spa area. Children who regularly wear diapers must wear rubber pants with elastic leg over cloth diapers. Playtex swimmers or similar commercial swim diapers must be changed in the restroom.
- 6. No glass of any kind is allowed in the pool area. Beverages and food may be consumed in the pool area only if contained in plastic, metal or unbreakable containers. No food or drink is allowed in the pool itself.
- 7. Smoking is not permitted in the pool area at any time.
- 8. All persons shall take a cleansing shower before entering the pool or spa. Any person having an apparent skin disease, sore, inflamed eyes, cough, cold, nasal or ear discharge or any communicable disease shall not use the pool or spa.
- 9. Proper swim attire is required in the pool area at all times. No cut-offs or bobby pins are permitted in the pool or spa, as these may cause damage to the pool equipment or plaster. Earrings are not recommended in the pool. Long hair should be secured or otherwise tied up.
- 10. Conduct in the pool area must be orderly. Games, running, horseplay, noisy behavior and unnecessary splashing are not permitted. Diving is not allowed. Aquatic games must cease if other swimmers are in the pool. Offenders will be asked to leave.
- 11. Noise must be kept at a minimum at all times. Excessive noise such as yelling and screaming is not permitted. Radios are not allowed unless used with headphones.
- 12. No person under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drug shall use the pool or spa.
- 13. For the safety of others, electrical devices must not be used near the pool.
- 14. Inflatable rafts and other pool toys are permitted only if their use does not interfere with the use and enjoyment of the pool by other residents. Such items must be immediately removed from the pool if more than 10 people are in the water.
- 15. No skateboarding, roller skating or bicycling are allowed in the pool area at any time.
- 16. No animals are allowed in the pool area at any time.
- 17. Pool keys are not to be duplicated or given to anyone else.
- 18. Women who are or may be pregnant should seek the advice of a physician regarding spa use and limit their time in the pool.

- 19. In case of emergency call 911. The emergency phone is located near the rear entrance of the clubhouse.
- 20. The first aid kit is located on the wall near the rear entrance to the clubhouse.
- 21. The street address of the facility is 1701 SE 109^{th} Place, Vancouver, WA 98664.
- 22. If one is ill with diarrhea or vomiting in the previous two weeks, or has a disease transmissible in water, use of the pool or spa is prohibited.
- 23. Those with risk of seizure, heart or circulatory problems should not swim alone.
